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As we age, memory loss and related cognitive problems become more common. Early diagnosis and intervention can reverse these challenges for some people and relieve their intensity for others. Expert evaluation of symptoms such as forgetfulness, depression, disorientation and agitation will determine if the patient is experiencing normal age-related changes or a more pervasive decline in brain functioning.

**THE PIEDMONT HOSPITAL MEMORY CLINIC.**

Since family caregivers are usually the first to recognize a loved one's confusion and behavioral changes, they play a crucial role in making sure the patient receives the best medical evaluation and treatment available. That is why the clinic provides education, support and guidance for all family caregivers.

Patients seeking evaluation will be seen by the clinic's neurologist. Patients also are scheduled for an assessment with the clinic's neuropsychologist who will determine the extent and nature of the patient's problems. The clinic's social worker will meet with the family and the patient to offer further education about the disease, provide information on resources and assistance, and be available for ongoing consultation and support.



When the evaluation is completed, the patient and family are invited to a care conference where evaluation results are presented and treatment plans discussed. The clinic team collaborates closely with the patient's primary care physician who receives the results of all evaluations. The social worker maintains contact with the patient's family to discuss any new issues that emerge. Follow-up visits to the neurologist and neuropsychologist will be offered as needed.
